1. World leaders -
  - a. Raise up leaders who will follow Christ and bring down leaders who are enemies of Christ and who are persecuting His people  
*He must increase, but I must decrease. John 3:30*
  - b. World leaders who will work together for this world God gave us
  - c. Leaders would build bridges of peace with and between other countries
2. God would ignite a passion to follow Jesus -  
*You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him. Deut 13:4*  
*May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ.*

- a. Through our College Park Global Outreach partnerships
    - i. Bethesda Christian School in Liberia - a school affiliated with the Child Evangelism Fellowship, trains children to be followers of Jesus Christ who will have an impact in their country for Him.
    - ii. Caspian Fire - helps to get the full Bible translated and printed in the local language in the Caspian region, as well as sends workers in church planting efforts.
    - iii. Good News for India - trains Indian nationals to reach north India with the gospel, including one of the largest unreached people groups in the world.
    - iv. Heart for Lebanon - seeks to meet physical and emotional needs by creating faith-defining environments that give under-resourced refugee children and families in Lebanon the chance to encounter God and grow spiritually.
    - v. Ukranian Evangelical Theological Seminary (UETS) - trains leaders for the church as well as in the political, legal, and social arenas.
    - vi. World Relief Cambodia - seeks to incarnate Christ among these hurting people through micro-enterprise development, HIV/AIDS education and care, maternal and natal health training and anti-trafficking programs in order to build the Church in Cambodia.
  - b. Through our College Park missionaries
    - i. We have missionaries in the following countries and regions: United States, Canada, Guatemala, Peru, Brazil, Angola, Europe, Caspian region, Northeast, Southeast, and East Asia, Mediterranean, Arabian Gulf, New Zealand, Middle East, Pacific Region
  - c. Through Gospel-teaching churches around the world
3. Oppressed people around the world -  
*It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed. Deut. 31:8*  
*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction....2 Cor. 1:4-7*
- a. Victims of ethnic cleansing, sex trafficking, slave labor, religious persecution, famine, disease, and war.
  - b. Uyghurs - large unreached people group in internment camps in China
4. Revival -  
*Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life. John 8:12*  
*Jesus said to him, I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6*
