

Mom's Connection Step 1: Frequently Asked Questions

What is Mom's Connection?

Mom's Connection is a community igniting a passion to follow Jesus in motherhood. Mom's Connection Step 1 includes expectant mothers through those whose youngest child enters kindergarten. Registrants are placed in small groups to meet together twice a month at church either on weekday mornings or evenings. We also have optional playdates, mom's nights, and couples' events throughout the year.

When does Mom's Connection meet?

Mom's Connection Step 1 meets when it is convenient for you as we offer a variety of options. There are two different groups that meet alternating Thursday mornings from 9:45-11:30 a.m. at church. There is also an evening group that meets on Wednesday evening at church from 6:30-8 p.m.

Our group has 2 semesters fall (September to December) and spring (January to May). Women just commit to one semester at a time.

What is a typical meeting like?

Moms will benefit from the wisdom of seasoned men and women who give talks on such topics as shepherding a child's heart, prayer, friendship, and communication in marriage. Each meeting includes prayer time, watching a speaker video, discussion questions, enjoying a light brunch or snacks and fellowship time. Throughout the year as it is possible, we will have opportunities to participate in a service project, engage in creative activities, and learn about women living and mothering overseas in missions.

When is registration?

Registration is required for each semester of Mom's Connection (September–December & January–May). First semester registration will begin in August. Second semester registration opens in December.

How much does Mom's Connection cost?

The fee for moms is \$35 per semester.
