


"<u>Friendship</u> seems as necessary an element of a comfortable existence in this world as fire or water, or even air itself." – Charles Spurgeon

#### 1. AFFECTION

We love our friends.

- for he loved him as his own soul. (1 Sam. 20:17)
- And there was much weeping on the part of all; they embraced Paul and kissed him (Acts 20:37)

#### 2. CONSTANCY


We are committed to our friends.

- A friend loves at all times... (Prov. 17:17)
- Then Jonathan made a covenant with David, because he loved him as his own soul. (1 Sam 18:3)



#### 3. TRANSPARENCY

We let our friends in.



• But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with <u>one another</u>, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)

Honesty + Acceptance = Real Friendship

#### 4. CANDOR

We talk honestly with our friends.

 Better is open rebuke than hidden love.

Faithful are the wounds of a friend; profuse are the kisses of an enemy.

(Prov. 27:5-6)



#### 5. EMPATHY

We seek to understand our friends.



- Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. (Gal. 6:2)
- Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. (Rom. 12:15)

• A dishonest man spreads strife, and a whisperer separates close friends. (Prov 16:28)

#### BEFORE CREATION: THE TRIUNE FRIENDSHIP

"Father ... you loved me before the foundation of the world." (John 17:24)

**CREATION: FRIENDS ARE GOOD** 

Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him." (Gen 2:18)

"God made us in such a way that we cannot enjoy paradise without friends." – Tim Keller

SIN: FRIENDSHIP BROKEN

And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day,

and the man and his wife <u>hid themselves</u> from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. (Gen 3:8)

#### **COVENANT-MAKERS: GOD'S FRIENDS**

- Enoch: "Enoch walked with God..." (Gen 5:24)
- Noah: "Noah walked with God." (Gen 6:9)
- Abraham: "the offspring of Abraham, my friend" (Isa. 41:8)
- Moses: "Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend." (Exod. 33:11)

ISRAEL: NOT GOD'S FRIENDS

Put no trust in a neighbor; have no confidence in a friend (Micah 7:5)

#### JESUS: CALLS US FRIENDS

"No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you <u>friends</u>..." (John 15:15)

"Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his <u>friends</u>." (John 15:13)

JESUS: CALLS US FRIENDS

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you [as <u>friends!</u>], you also are to love one another." (John 13:34)

#### JESUS: THE GREATEST FRIEND

- 1. AFFECTION: "greater love" (John 15:13)
- 2. CONSTANCY: "to the end" (Jn 13:1; Matt. 28:20)
- 3. TRANSPARENCY: "all heard" (John 15:15)
- 4. CANDOR: "cuts to the heart" (Acts 2:37)
- 5. EMPATHY: "sympathizes" (Heb. 4:15)
- 6. TRUSTWORTHINESS: "no condemnation" (Rom 8:1)
