Appoint Elders Who <u>Are</u>

Above reproach (Blameless).UprightHusband of one wife.HolyChildren are believers.DisciplinedHospitable.Hold firm to the WordLover of good.Able to teachSelf-controlled.Able to rebuke

Titus 1:7-9

Appoint Elders who <u>are not</u>

- But not open to the charge of Debauchery
- (Excessive endulgence of sensual pleasures)
- Insubordination (Defiance of Authority)
- Not Arrogant
- Quick-tempered
- Drunkards
- Violent
- Greedy for Gain

Titus 1:7-9

Rebuke and/or get rid of False Prophets

Who are:

Insubordinate

Empty talkers

Deceivers Detestable

Disobedient Unfit for any good work

Preaching for shameful gain and charging money for the circumcision of Greek Christians

Trying to combine Christ's teachings with the Jewish and Greek myths.

Titus 1:10-16

• Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness,

First - knowledge of the truth (and believe)

Second - leads to godliness (which includes good works)

• Titus 3:8 The saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed in God may be careful to devote themselves to good works.

Belief leads to works!

God's word was discredited (2:5)

People make evil accusations (2:8)

The Christian message was not attractive or compelling.

- Dignified
- Show integrity
- Sound in speech

Young Men

- Self- Controlled
- Model of Good works
- Show integrity
- Dignity
- Sound speech
- Why? So an opponent will be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about you

Titus 2:6-8

Slaves (Employees)

- Be Submissive to masters (employers)
- Well pleasing
- Not argumentative,
- Not pilfering
- Showing all good faith
- Why? So that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior

Older Women

- Reverent in Behavior
- Not slanderers
- Not slaves to much wine
- Model of good behavior to the younger women
- Teach the younger women how to...
- Looking to their needs

Mary, Esther, Sarah, Ruth




Younger Women

- 3. We will be rewarded for our deeds (2 Cor 5:10)

Proof of our Salvation

James 1:22 But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves.

James 2:20 But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?
